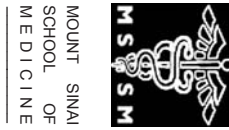

A one day practical, clinical Post-Graduate Course designed to provide obstetricians, gynecologists, pediatricians, adolescent medicine physicians, primary care physicians and allied health providers with new advances in prevention, diagnosis and management of gynecological disorders.
