- Prepare and inform families that the practice may ask personal and sensitive questions about the family as part of routine history-taking in order to provide comprehensive health care

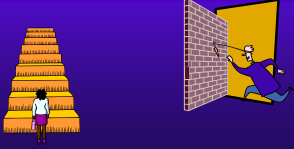
