Faculty Agreements - Quick Reference Guide: All outside professional activities must be approved by your Department Chair prior to your participation in the activity. Agreements submitted to the COI office must include the Attestation of Compliance with Institutional Policies for Relationship with Outside Entities ("Attestation Form") which acknowledges faculty responsibilities and also Chair approval. All agreements and attestation forms should be retained by you. All financial relationships must be disclosed on your Disclosure Profile via eDMS after approval.
